South African reaching for the stars!

1. Shobubela Xusa is one of South Africa's most successful young scientists. His passion for science started when he was a six-year-old. He explains: 'One of my earliest memories of my childhood in Grahamstown in the Eastern Cape was seeing a plane flying overhead dropping abortion pamphlets in 1984.' Xusa was fascinated by the aeroplane. From there he began to build rockets in his mother's kitchen, and sometimes even missing the fuel completely and having a mini-explosion which luckily caused no real damage but did create a mess!

2. From the Eastern Cape, Xusa's family moved to Johannesburg where he was given a scholarship to attend St. John's College. There he developed his love for science, especially aerodynamics. With the guidance of teachers, he built the Phoenix, a rocket which reached the height of 1 200 metres. This was done in 2003. He was 14 at the time and with this achievement he won an award at the Eastern National Science Expo as well as breaking the South African Amateur Altitude Record.

3. When Xusa was in Matric, at the age of 18, he had already started to achieve success as a young scientist. That year he attended the International Youth Science Fair in Sweden, and he won two grand awards at the first International Science and Engineering Fair which was held in New Mexico, in the United States. His awards were in the Energy and Transportation category.

4. His project was a revolutionary cheaper rocket fuel. He explained that when he found out that rocket fuels were very expensive, he thought that the money could be better spent on other projects such as research into AIDS and HIV. So he decided on devising a way to make rocket fuels cheaper.

5. One of his more unusual awards is a planet that is named after him! The NASA-affiliated Lincoln Laboratory named a minor planet after him. Planet 25982 was discovered in 2000 – the same time that Xusa was becoming serious about rocketry. It is now officially known as 25982 Xusa.

6. After matriculating, Xusa went on to study chemical engineering at the University of Cape Town, until he received the news that he had been granted a bursary to study at Harvard University in the USA.

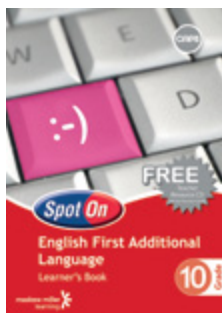

Unit 2: Revision of summary skills

In the previous activity, you had to do a simple summary. It is important to revise and practice summary skills as often as you can during your first year at school. What's more, summary skills are valuable life and study skills, so when you *have* improved your summary skills, you are refining and improving one of the most useful skills you'll ever acquire.

Follow these three simple steps when you do a summary:

1. **Skim** the text to get an overall impression of the content. Skimming is a reading skill, which enables you to glance through a text to see what it is about.
2. **Underline** or highlight the topic sentence (sentences in a paragraph that capture the main idea of that paragraph). Identify only the main idea and leave out examples, explanations and definitions. Try to use your own words as far as possible.
3. **When** you do a summary exercise, always stick to the word allocation, or you'll lose marks. Don't forget to write the number of words you have used at the end of the summary in square brackets, for example (20 words).

Unit 7: Sensory receptors

All sense organs are modified to detect stimuli from both the internal and external environment. Sensory receptors can be relatively basic in structure – like those found in the skin – or they can be part of complex sense organs, such as the eye or ear. Each sense organ is structurally suited to receive certain environmental stimuli.

Receptors detect a variety of stimuli, such as light, sound, touch, temperature, pressure, pain and chemicals. When receiving stimuli from the outside environment, exteroceptors are used. These are sensory receptors in the body that react to stimuli from outside the body. Interoceptors are sensory receptors that react to changes within the body. Some examples of such internal changes are pH (the degree of acidity or alkalinity) of a solution or the concentration of glucose and oxygen in the blood. These receptors work to maintain a constant internal environment in the body. In this module, you will learn about the eye and the ear. You will learn about touch in Module 8 when the skin is discussed.

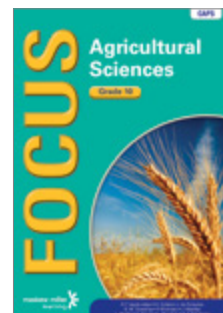

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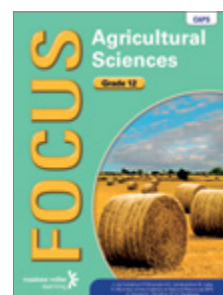

2.3 Stomach

- Non-ruminants have a single stomach of only one part. These animals chew their food and swallow it once. The stomach is a pear-shaped, sac-like structure with thick muscular walls. The muscular walls contain a large number of glands that secrete gastric juice.
- Ruminants have a complex stomach that is divided into four chambers: rumen, reticulum, omasum and abomasum. Ruminants swallow their food and regurgitate it later to chew it. This is known as 'chewing the cud'.

2.4 Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, thin tube that is divided into three parts: duodenum, jejunum and ileum. The small intestine is adapted for the absorption of soluble digested food molecules.

- The small intestine is very long (approximately 12 m long in pigs).
- The small intestine has many folds that increase the surface area for absorbing nutrients.
- These folds are covered with thousands of tiny finger-like villi, which further increase the total surface area.
- Each villus is covered with tiny projections, called microvilli, which further increase the surface area of the villi.
- Each villus contains a network of blood and lymph capillaries. The blood capillaries are used to absorb and transport nutrients that are absorbed by the villi.
- The thin layer of epithelial cells that line the villi are specially adapted for the absorption of nutrients. The surface of the epithelial cells contains various carrier molecules, which are used to absorb specific chemicals and nutrients.

2.5 Large intestine

Undigested food that is not absorbed in the small intestine passes into the large intestine. The large intestine is a large tube divided into three parts: caecum, colon and rectum. The main function of the large intestine is to absorb water from waste and store this waste in the body. In the large intestine, the undigested food becomes more solid to form faeces. The faeces is made up of undigested food, fibre and waste, and is stored and compacted in the rectum.

2.6 Anus

The anus acts like a valve and is controlled by a sphincter muscle. When this muscle relaxes, waste matter stored in the rectum is released, or expelled, from the body.

Unit 3: The internal structure of the digestive system of ruminants

Each part of a ruminant's complex stomach has a different structure and function.

3.1 Rumen

The rumen is the largest stomach and it contains billions of bacteria and protozoa that do most of the cow's digestion. No digestive juices are secreted here, but there are many tiny finger-like projections called papillae. These papillae increase the surface area and act as heating coils to keep the temperature constant.

3.2 Reticulum

The reticulum has a honeycomb-like structure. Ruminants regurgitate the food that enters the rumen into the reticulum where the food is regurgitated and chewed again.

3.3 Omasum

The lining of the omasum has many leaf-like folds that absorb water from the remaining food. These folds are called papillae and have the ability to grind food particles between the horny and muscular bands.

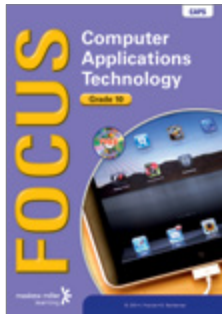
3.4 Abomasum

The abomasum is similar to the single stomach of non-ruminants. Digestive juices are secreted and digestion takes place in the abomasum. Food moves from the abomasum to the small intestine, which is slightly longer than that of non-ruminants. Food then moves to the large intestine, which includes the caecum, colon and rectum. Finally, waste products are expelled via the anus.

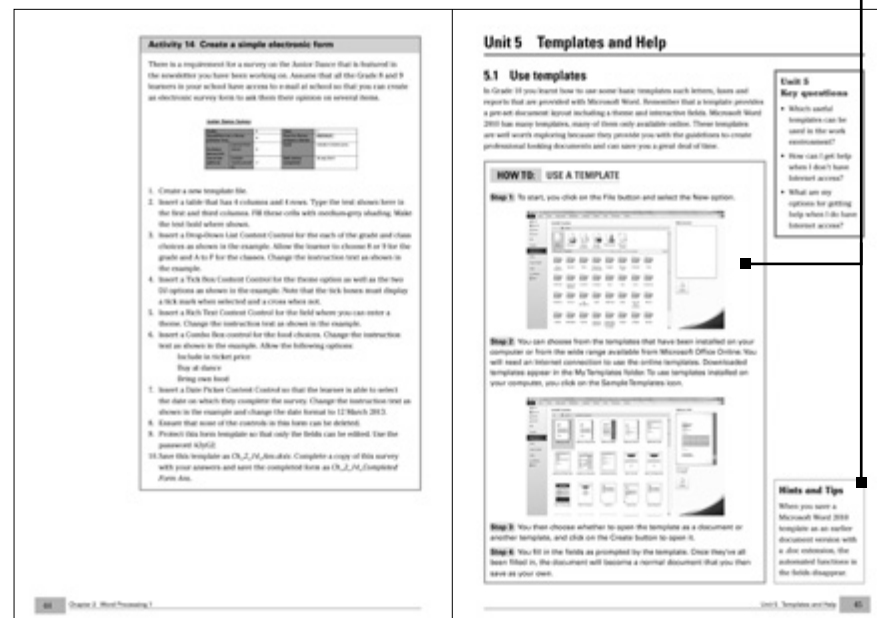
