



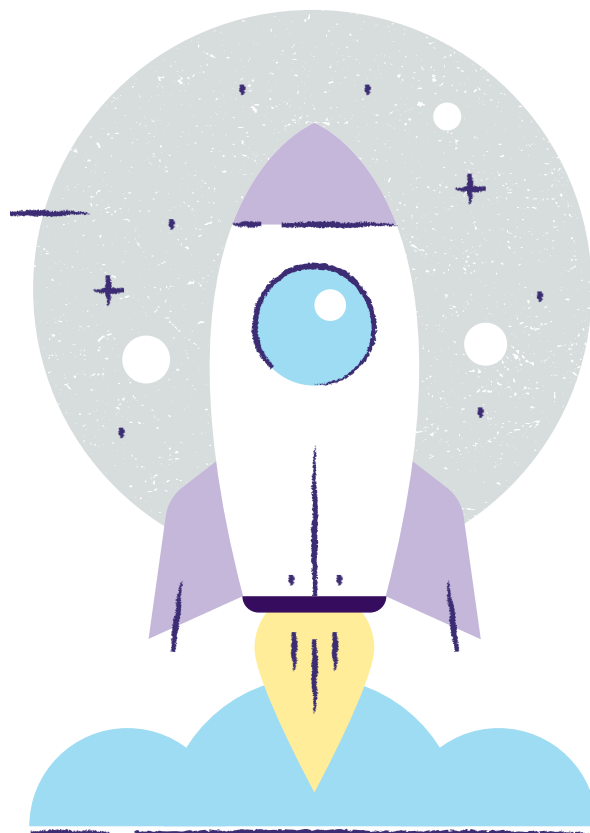

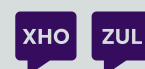

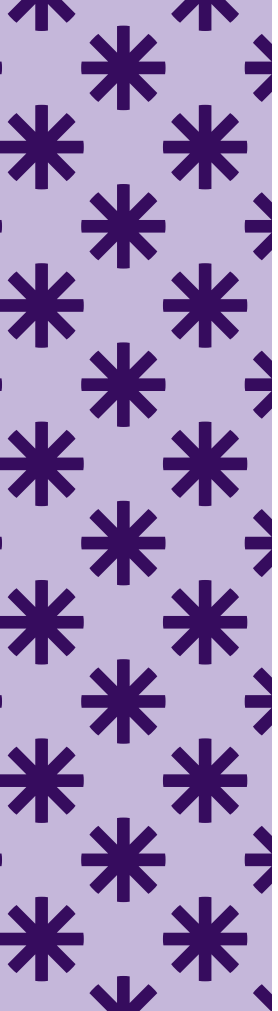

Each story has been planned and written in the language in which it is published so that the natural patterns and rich expression inherent in each language is captured.



Level 1: 1 word or 2-word phrases per page; strong visual cues aid understanding. Lots of repetition.



Level 7: One paragraph (1–5 sentences) per page; strong visual cues aid understanding. Uses direct speech and past tense. Introduces information-style texts.

Level 10: 1–2 longer paragraphs; more complex language structures and some visual cues to aid understanding. Stories and informational texts included.



Level 5: 1–3 sentences per page; strong visual cues aid understanding. Some direct speech. Lots of repetition.



Level 11: 2–3 paragraphs per page. Limited visual cues. Stories and informational texts included.



Level 6: 1–4 sentences per page; strong visual cues aid understanding. Direct speech and past tense. Lots of repetition.



Level 12: 2–4 paragraphs per page. Limited visual cues. Stories and informational texts included.

Levels 1 to 4: Suitable for Grade 1
Levels 5 to 8: Suitable for Grade 2

Levels 9 to 12: Suitable for Grade 3

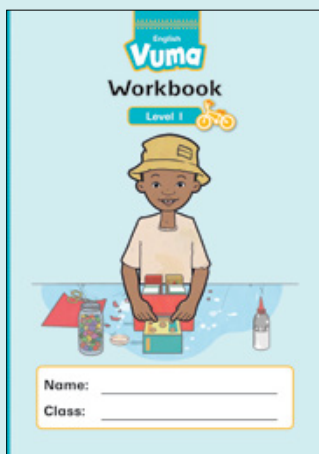
